Explain: The review area contains 1 aquatic resource, labeled as W-2/Pond on the attached figure that is 0.3 acres in size. The feature is located in a industrial development near Interstate-94, on the southern side and is utilized as a stormwater pond. In a review of aerial photos from Waukesha County GIS in 1941 and 1950, no wetness signatures near or within the present-day feature are present. Aerial photos from 1980, 1990, and 1995 show that the area of the current feature was utilized as a constructed parking lot. Between 1995 and 2000, the feature was constructed to the size it is today. A culvert is present on the southeast edge of the feature. Based on aerial photos showing a parking lot, the feature was constructed in upland.

In accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the United States: artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used exclusively for such purposes as settling basins.
