Wetland 4	5.15	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	Wetland 4 is part of a large wetland complex that extends outside of the project boundary. The contour map submitted in the De Minimis application indicates that Wetland 4 is a depressional basin, completely surrounded by uplands. The Corps reviewed topographic maps from 1909 and 2013. The 1909 Rockford MN topographic map indicates that Wetland 4 may have been connected to a larger wetland complex, east of Pioneer Tail, but does not show any surface water connection between the wetland complex and an a(1)-a(3) water. This was confirmed by the 2013 topographic map which shows no possible a(1)-a(3) waters within the vicinity of Wetland 4. Google Earth aerial imagery confirmed the findings from the contour and topographic maps. Wetland 4 does not share a surface water connection with an a(1)-a(3) water. Therefore, Wetland 4 is not considered a water of the U.S. under the Navigable Waters Protection Rule.
