## C. Additional comments to support AJD:

The aquatic resource being evaluated is Wetland 1A (1.90 acre) shown on the attached figure labeled MVP-2018-02804-EJW Page 2 of 2. The review area for this determination is shown on the attached figure labeled MVP-2018-02804-EJW Page 2 of 2. The nearest a (3) water is the Rum River, approximately 2,107 feet east of the review area.

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Based upon information gathered as a result of the desktop review and the wetland delineation report, Corps staff determined that Wetland 1A is wholly surrounded by uplands and lacks an unbroken surface connection to a water of the United States. Wetland 1A does not abut the Rum River. Wetland 1A does not abut a TNW, lake, pond, or impoundment of a jurisdictional water in a typical year. Therefore, Wetland 1A does not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR and is not a water of the US.

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
