Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: W-1 is a 0.15 acre stormwater pond that was constructed in uplands and is not a water of the US. This was confirmed by review of historic aerial imagery which show the area to be an open field/pasture in 2008, prior to conversion to a retention pond. This pond was constructed for an abandoned development according to review and interpretation of aerial imagery. The wetland delineation shows points immediately surrounding the pond to not exhibit all three characteristics of a wetland. These are data points 1, 4, 6, and 8 in the delineation. These points show similar characteristics to the original state of the area under review, leading to the decision that the area was upland prior to conversion. The jurisdictional determination for this pond is in accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the US; artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used exclusively for such purposes as stock watering, irrigation, settling basins or rice growing.
