Explain: The review area contains three aquatic resources (labeled as Wetland 2, Wetland 3, and Wetland 4 on Figures) that are isolated depressions with no surface or shallow subsurface connection to any waters of the U.S. including the nearest tributary which is an unnamed tributary of Duck Creek located approximately 320 feet to the northwest. These wetlands do not border, neighbor, nor are contiguous with another water of the U.S. They are not separated from other waters of the United States (WOUS) by manmade dikes, barriers, or berms. The surrounding land use consists of commercial development, agricultural fields, and undeveloped wooded and grassland areas, precluding an ecological connection to a WOUS.

These aquatic resources do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined these aquatic features are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.


