The review area consists of an existing access road approximately 192 feet in length by 12 feet in width located within a wet meadow wetland area, as shown in MVP-2021-01289-CJH, Figures 1 and 2. Based on a review of historic and current aerial photography, USGS Topographic Maps, National Hydrography Dataset, Wisconsin Wetland Inventory, and June 2021 WDNR, Wetland Identification Report, we have determined Wetland 1 does not meet the NWPR adjacency definition. Wetland 1 is an isolated concave wetland surrounded by upland features. A surface hydrologic connection from Wetland 1 to an (a)(1)-(3) water does not exist. Wetland 1 as described above extends outside of the review area and this larger area was analyzed as part of the NWPR jurisdictional determination. The larger wetland area does not meet the NWPR adjacency definition and is not connected to an (a)(1)-(3) water.
