Explain: The review area for this determination is limited to the Incidental Portion of Wetland 1, as shown on the attached figures labeled 2022-00446-BGO Figures 1-8 of 8. This wetland area is a stormwater detention pond that was constructed in uplands under a previous project for the development of the Park View Subdivision in 2001 (MVP-2001-01418-GAE). This was confirmed by reviewing historical imagery and previous project plans, which shows the area was originally grassed uplands until grading occurred for the construction of the subdivision and stormwater pond in 2003. This is further supported by the national wetland inventory, which identifies this wetland area as an excavated basin - PUBGx. The Wright County Soil Survey also shows this area to be predominantly non-hydric soils.

The non-jurisdictional determination for this stormwater pond is in accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps generally does not consider the following waters to be Waters of the United States; "Artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used exclusively for such purposes as stock watering, irrigation, settling basins, or rice growing." Based on this review, the Incidental Portion of Wetland 1 was constructed in dry land for stormwater management purposes and is not jurisdictional under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
