Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area includes 1 wetland, W-3 (0.16 acre). Based on the delineation report provided by raSmith, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI DNR) Hillshade, historic aerial photography, and Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) hydric soil indicators, W-3 is a drainage ditch constructed in upland and draining only upland. Based on historic aerial photography, W-3 was formed as a drainage ditch sometime around 2015. WI DNR Hillshade and historic aerial photography show a lack of relatively permanent flow from W-3 to a downstream water. NRCS soil map from the delineation report shows that the area where the ditch was constructed does not include hydric soil.

In accordance with the 2008 Rapanos guidance and the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.; non-tidal drainage and irrigation ditches excavated on dry land. Further clarification is provided in the December 2, 2008 Revised Guidance on Clean Water Act Jurisdiction following the Supreme Court Decision in Rapanos v. U.S. and Carabell v. U.S. issued jointly by the Corps and EPA which indicates that ditches excavated wholly in and draining only uplands and do not carry a relatively permanent flow are not waters of the United States.
