This determination is only applicable to the aquatic resource labeled Storm Pond 1 in the review area shown on the attached figure labeled MVP-2008-05736-MVM Page 3 of 6. Storm Pond 1 was constructed in 2008 to serve as a settling basin for the Chaska Par 30 Golf Course. A delineation map from 2008 was submitted by the consultant to document the storm water pond was constructed in upland. A review of available historic aerial imagery did not show historic hydrology indicators within the current location of the stormwater pond prior to construction. In additon, the Corps provided a determination during a pre-application consultation meeting in 2008 that no permit was required to construct the stormwater pond. Therefore, Storm Pond 1 is not a water of the U.S. per the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.: Artificial lakes or ponds created by excavating and/or diking dry land to collect and retain water and which are used for such purposes as stock watering, irrigation, settling basins, or rice growing.
