The aquatic resources being evaluated are Wetland_1 and Wetland_2 shown on the attached figures labeled MVP-2018-02530-EJW Pages 1 of 2 through Page 2 of 2. The review area for this determination is labeled on the attached figures. The nearest (a)(3) water is School Lake, located approximately 0.72 miles southeast of the review area. Wetland_1 and Wetland_2 have no surface connection to School Lake and are not inundated by flooding from School Lake. Based upon information gathered as a result of the desktop review and wetland_1 and Wetland_2 are wholly surrounded by uplands and lack natural intermittent or perennial surface connection to a water of the United States. Wetland_1 and Wetland_2 do not abut a TNW, lake, pond, or impoundment of a jurisdictional water in a typical year. Therefore, Wetland_1 and Wetland_2 do not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR and are not waters of the US.
