The wetlands identified as Wetland 1 and Wetland 2 on the attached figure labeled MVP-2021-00957-SJW: Figure 1 do not meet the definition of "adjacent wetlands". These features are isolated/non-adjacent wetlands which do not maintain a hydrologic connection to a downstream intermittent or perennial tributary. A review of available information including the Wisconsin Wetland Inventory, Google Earth, USFS Topo Mapping, etc., confirmed that these wetlands are isolated features situated in an agricultural field which is currently utilized for the production of commodity crops. Wetland signatures are clearly visible within the limits of Wetlands 1 and 2. However these signatures do not extent outside of the delineated limits of these features. There are no culverts or other type of feature associated with either of these wetlands which would create a hydrologic connection to a downstream tributary. Wetland 1 and 2 are surrounded entirely by uplands. Therefore, these wetlands are physically removed from the nearest A(1)-A(3) water. There is no evidence that Wetland 1 or Wetland 2 are directly abutting an A(1)-A(3) water. Based on this information, Wetland 1 and Wetland 2 are (b)(1) non-adjacent wetlands and are therefore not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
