This wetland is not bordering, contiguous to, or neighboring another WOUS nor is this aquatic resource separated from another WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. The closest NHD tributary is approximately 1,875 feet to the southwest of the wetland and the closest NWI wetland is 1,025 feet to the northwest.

The wetland located within the review area does not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Furthermore, this wetland is hydrologically isolated with no surface or shallow subsurface connections to a water of the United States and does not have an ecological interconnection due to existing disturbance. Therefore, the Corps has determined that this wetland is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
