W-1	0.01	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	W-1 is a pocket depression surrounded by upland, based on the delineation report and aerial photographs. The only inlets/outlets are by overland sheet flow. The nearest tributary is the Mukwonago River which flows into Lower Phantom Lake approximately 1,900 feet to the north of W-1. Based on FEMA's National Flood Hazard Layer, W-1 is in the Zone of Minimal Flood Hazard; therefore, it would not be flooded by an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water in a typical year. There are no artificial or natural structures separating W-1 from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water.
