³ A stand-alone TNW determination is completed independently of a request for an AJD. A stand-alone TNW determination is conducted for a specific segment of river or stream or other type of waterbody, such as a lake, where independent upstream or downstream limits or lake borders are established. A stand-alone TNW determination should be completed following applicable guidance and should NOT be documented on the AJD form. ⁴ Some excluded waters, such as (b)(2) and (b)(4), may not be specifically identified on the AJD form unless a requestor specifically asks a Corps district to do so. Corps Districts may, in case-by-case instances, choose to identify some or all of these waters within the review area.

⁵ Because of the broad nature of the (b)(1) exclusion and in an effort to collect data on specific types of waters that would be covered by the (b)(1) exclusion, four sub-categories of (b)(1) exclusions were administratively created for the purposes of the AJD Form. These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

W-A	0.05 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	surrounded by uplands. A review of offsite aerial
W-B	3.04 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	imagery shows that W-E continues offsite, but lacks a
W-C	0.19 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	surface water connection to any water of the US
W-E	1.35 acres	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland	(WOUS). W-A continues offsite to the north to an open water wetland complex, but the LiDAR in the delineation shows a berm along the eastern boundary of the complex that severs any jurisdictional connection. The agent confirmed that he had walked the berm onsite and did not see any culverted connection through the berm. Ephemeral Swales 1 and 2 only have water in direct response to rain so they are not jurisdictional waters under the NWPR. W-A, W-B, W-C, and W-E are defined as non-adjacent wetlands and are not jurisdictional WOUS under the NWPR.
