There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

## 2. Non-regulated waters/wetlands (check if applicable):1

Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area includes one delineated aquatic resource feature which is identified as Wetland 3 (4,535 square feet) on the attached figure labeled MVP-2022-00673-SJW: Figure 1. As stated in the wetland delineation report which was submitted as part of the AJD request, Wetland 3 is a ruderal wet meadow depression located near the end of a cul-de-sac on Consolidated Court. Based on a review of aerial imagery from the Outagamie County GIS website, it appears that Wetland 3 is an upland constructed stormwater feature which was created at some point between the year 2000 and 2005. The 2005 aerial image clearly shows a berm/mound surrounding the entire wetland feature and there are no other wetlands that directly abut this feature. The Wisconsin Wetland Inventory mapping has this feature situated in the middle of a mapped wetland. However, based on the data presented within the wetland delineation report, there are no wetlands sitated in the same location or immediately adjacent to Wetland 3, which further suggests that this wetland was constructed entirely in uplands. There are no wetlands that directly abut this feature, and this feature does not appear to maintain a hydrologic connection to the nearest waterbody (unnamed tributary) which is located approximately 0.02 miles to the south.

Based on this information, the Corps has determined that Wetland 3 is an upland constructed stormwater feature. The preamble for 33 CFR 328, published in Federal Register Volume 51, Number 219, November 13, 1986 (page 41217) states "For clarification, it should be noted that we generally do not consider the following waters to be Waters of the United States....(b)(10) Stormwater control features constructed or excavated in upland or in non-jurisdictional waters to convey, treat, infiltrate, or store stormwater runoff." Based on these factors and the site specific details, it has been determined that Wetland 3 is not a water of the U.S. and is not jurisdictional under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act as defined by 33 CFT Part 328.3(b).
