#### A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

#### 2. Non-regulated waters/wetlands (check if applicable):<sup>1</sup>

Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area includes two wetlands labeled W1 (0.09 acre) and Roadside Ditch (0.18 acre). Based on the delineation report provided by Wetland & Waterway Consulting, LLC, Wisconsin Wetland Inventory, and historic aerial photos, W1 is an agricultural drainage ditch constructed in upland and draining only upland. Historic aerial photos indicate W1 was constructed sometime between 2008-2018. Based on historic Google Earth images and hydric soil indicators provided in the delineation report, W1 does not provide relatively permanent flow.

Based on historical aerial photos included in the delineation report, roadside ditch was constructed in upland sometime between the years of 2011 and 2014 as part of a road expansion project. Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI DNR) Hillshade and aerial photos show roadside ditch receives input from surface water conveyance and two stormwater ponds. Historic aerial photos from the delineation report do not show roadside ditch as having relatively permanent flow.

In accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330) and the 2008 Rapanos guidance, the Corps does not generally consider the following activities to be waters of the United States; non-tidal drainage and irrigation ditches excavated on dry land. Further clarification is provided in the December 2, 2008 Revised Guidance on Clean Water Act Jurisdiction following the Supreme Court Decision in Rapanos v. U.S. and Carabell v. U.S. issued jointly by the Corps and EPA which indicates that ditches excavated wholly in and draining only uplands and do not carry a relatively permanent flow are not waters of the United States. Based on this information, W1 and roadside ditch are not waters of the United States, and are, therefore, not subject to Corps jurisdiction under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, or Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbor Act.
