| The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The review area includes a 3.49-acre site |

| located west of I-494, and northeast of Gerard Drive, in the City of Eden Prairie, Minnesota. The site consists of a public recreational park with manicured lawn and scattered trees. Kjolhaug Environmenta |
| performed a field investigation of the site on October 28, 2020 and looked at two sample points within |
| the review area. Sample Point (SP) A did not meet one primary or two secondary indicators of wetland hydrology and therefore was determined upland. SP-B did not meet one primary or two secondary |
| indicators of wetland hydrology or at least one hydric soil indicator and therefore was determined upland. These findings were confirmed by review from local wetland experts from the State of |
| Minnesota. The NWI map shows no wetlands within the review area. A review of aerial imagery (2003- |
| 2006, 2008-2020) did not conclusively show the presence of surface water. Given the information stated above, the review area is composed entirely of dry land. |
