This determination is valid only for Wetland 2, Wetland 4, and Wetland 5. Wetlands 2, 4, and 5 are surrounded by non-hydric soils and are separated from Wetlands 1 and 3 by distance and changes in topography. These wetlands are not bordering, contiguous with, or neighboring another WOUS nor are these aquatic resources separated from another WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. The closest tributary is approximately 210 feet to the southwest of the nearest wetland (Wetland 5).

The wetlands located within the review area do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Furthermore, these wetlands are hydologically isolated with no surface or shallow subsurface connectons to a water of the United States and do not have an ecological interconnection due to existing disturbance. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetland 2, Wetland 4, and Wetland 5 are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
