His previous assignments include: platoon leader and executive officer, Company C, and adjutant, 54th Engineer Battalion (Combat), Wildflecken, Germany; assistant operations officer and maintenance officer, 326<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion, and company commander, 887<sup>th</sup> Engineer Company (Light Equipment), at Fort Campbell, Ky.; project engineer for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Kansas City District in Kansas City, Mo.; division plans officer, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, executive officer, 41<sup>st</sup> Engineer Battalion, and commander, Division Special Troops Battalion, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, Fort Drum, N.Y.; joint engineer staff officer and special assistant to the commander, U.S. Northern Command and North American Aerospace Defense Command, Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado Springs, Colo.

Price's military education includes the Engineer Officer Basic and Advance Courses, Fort Belvoir, Va. Command and General Staff College and the School of Advanced Military Studies, Fort Leavenworth, Kan.; and the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, Pa.
