Beneficial Use Categories

S = Stockpile - Material that is stockpiled at locations where it is available for removal and active beneficial use at other locations. Examples of the type of use include ice control, road maintenance, general fill, concrete or bituminous aggregate, etc.

L = Landfill - Material placed directly at a permanent location for a beneficial use. Subcategories are as follows:

1 = General fill placed for commercial, residential, industrial, or recreational development: or to reclaim excavated areas, such as sand and gravel pits; or to stabilize eroding areas.

2 = Fill placed for recreational beach enhancement, maintenance, or creation.

3 = Fill placed for environmental enhancement.

A = Public - Sites that are in public ownership at any level of government or non-profit organizations where the general public will benefit from the placement of material.

B = Private - Sites that are in private ownership of any type.
