
SECTOR UPPER MISSISSIPPI RIVER

 - > 238 bridges





SUCCESS STORY – FALL 2022 ATON


- > Supported Ag industry's record fall harvest.
- Extensive coordination between USACE and USCG facilitated maritime commerce.
 - > PATHFINDER coverage of southern AOR
- River Tenders overcame obstacles:
 - WYACONDA covered for SCIOTO while she was undergoing an industrial maintenance period.
 - SCIOTO and GASCONADE covered for CHEYENNE while she was not mission capable.
 - CHEYENNE covered for Sector OHIO valley to enable CHIPPEWA to transit to Memphis and assist Sector Lower Mississippi River.





SUCCESS STORY - TOWING VESSEL/DAM ALLISON

Towing Vessel allided with Lock and Dam 4 in Alma, WI. The vessel was safely recovered without negatively impacting the Mississippi River.
