Wabasha Harbor

The Wabasha Harbor is located in the city of Pepin, Wis. It is located at Upper Mississippi River mile 760.5 on the right descending bank. The City of Wabasha is the non-federal sponsor for the project and is required to furnish a suitable placement site for any dredged material..

Details

The small boat harbor was completed in June 1949 at a cost of \$41,650. The length of the small boat harbor is 740 feet and its widest part is approximately 600 feet. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is authorized to maintain the harbor to a depth of 5 feet below the low control pool elevation of 667.0 mean sea level.

Dredging

Since construction, the Wabasha Harbor has not been dredged by the Corps of Engineers.
