Red Wing Harbors

The Red Wing Small Boat and Commercial Harbors are located in the city of Red Wing, Minn. They are located at Upper Mississippi River mile 791.0 and 791.5 with the small boat harbor being down stream. The city of Red Wing is the non-federal sponsor for the project and has provided a suitable placement site for any dredged material.

Details

The small boat harbor was completed in October 1947 at a cost of \$8,702. The length of the small boat harbor is 700 feet. And its width is 430 feet. The commercial harbor was completed in September 1962 at a cost of \$155,255. The shape is similar to a triangle with a width of 1,700 feet by 900 feet. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is authorized to maintain the small boat harbor to a depth of 5 feet below the low control pool, and the commercial harbor to a depth of 9 feet below the low control pool elevation of 667 feet mean sea level.



Dredging

Since 1990, the Red Wing Harbors have been dredged once each. It occurred in 1997 and was completed with private funding.
