



The Hastings Small Boat Harbor is downstream of Lock and Dam 2 and in the city of Hastings, Minn. It is located at Upper Mississippi River mile 813.2 on the right descending bank. The city of Hastings is the non-federal sponsor for the project and is required to furnish a suitable placement site for the dredged material.

### Details

The harbor was completed in June 1957 at a cost of \$74,342. The length of the harbor is 500 feet. The width varies from 200 to 300 feet. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is authorized to maintain the harbor to a depth of 5 feet below the low control pool elevation of 675.0 feet mean sea level.

### Dredging

Since 1990, the Hastings Small Boat Harbor was dredged once. There was 4,375 cubic yards of material dredged from the harbor in 1997.
