Lansing Small Boat Harbor

The Lansing Small Boat Harbor is located just upstream of the city of Lansing, Iowa. It is located at Upper Mississippi River mile 663.5 on the right descending bank. The city of Lansing is the non-federal sponsor for the project and is required to furnish a suitable placement site for the dredged material.

Details

The small boat harbor was completed at a cost of \$42,100. The length of the harbor is 520 feet. The width is 170 feet. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is authorized to maintain the harbor to a depth of 5 feet below the low control pool elevation of 620.0 feet mean sea level.

Dredging

Since construction, the Lansing Small Boat Harbor has not been dredged by the Corps of Engineers.
