



## Camping

1. Please check-in at ranger station upon arrival.
2. You may make reservations up to 6 months (rolling window) in advance by calling 1-877-444-6777 or visit the website at [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov), TDD:1-877- 833-6777.
3. You are welcome to stay with us for up to 14 days in any 30-day period.
4. Campsite check-out is noon on the last day of your stay. You may use our picnicking, boating and swimming facilities to finish out your visit.
5. To help all guests enjoy the serenity of the northwoods, quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Please respect the privileges and privacy of others at all times.
6. Please keep all camping units and equipment on your assigned camping pad or driveway surface to protect the grass, shrubs and trees. Only one-wheeled camping unit per campsite.
7. Do not place unauthorized camping equipment or other items on a campsite or make a personal appearance at a campsite for the purpose of reserving it for future occupancy.
8. Easily accessible dump stations are available for refuse and gray water.

### Crosslake

The Pine River, a tributary of the Mississippi River, was once a creek connecting Crosslake with Upper and Lower Whitefish Lakes which are surrounded by 13 other natural lakes. The construction of the dam at Crosslake raised the water level, making channels between these lakes and forming the Pine River Reservoir, which is better known as the Whitefish Chain of Lakes. This 13,660 acre body of water, with 119 miles of shoreline, provides dozens of interesting bays for pleasure boating and fishing.

The Crosslake Campground, nestled among tall pines, is best known for its picturesque sunsets, beautiful beaches, well-maintained campsites, clean restrooms, showers, group picnic shelters, handicap accessible facilities, day use areas and much more. It is located just 10 minutes from shopping and paved bike paths. We hope you enjoy your visit!

### Campground Rules

1. Please keep all fires in the fireplace or grill.
2. Firewood restrictions are in effect to prevent the spread of forest insects and disease. For current information please contact park staff or visit [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov), select Crosslake Recreation Area, and refer to "Alerts and Important Information".
3. Drive with care. Watch for pedestrians and obey posted traffic regulations. Keep motorized and trailered vehicles on gravel and paved surfaces.
4. Off-road and All Terrain Vehicles, or ATVs, are not allowed.
5. Our boat ramps provide easy access to a spectacular chain of lakes. Please beach your boats only in designated areas and observe water safety rules.
6. Pets are welcome but please keep them leashed (no longer than 6 ft.) and attended. Owners are responsible for clean-up of all excrement.
7. We offer a safe campground where the use or display of firearms, air rifles, bow and arrows, slingshots and fireworks is not permitted.
8. Report any disturbances, vandalism or loss of property to the park ranger or campground host.
9. To keep swimming beaches safe and clean, no pets or glass containers are allowed.
