It is an isolated depressional basin with no visible natural or constructed outlets. USGS maps and elevation contours do not indicate above ground direct surface hydrological connection. Wetland 2 is located in FEMA Flood Zone A which is defined as an area inundated by 1-percentannual-chance flooding therefore it is not likely to be inundated by flooding from a paragraph (a)(1)-(3) water in a typical year. The closest tributary shown on the USGS Topographic map is North Creek approximately 450 feet east of Wetland 2.
