National Hydrography Dataset (NHD) and National Wetland Inventory (NWI) maps confirm the that the wetland has no surface water connections to intermittent or perennial tributaries. The closest tributary as shown on the USGS Topographic map is an unnamed stream approximately 3,800 feet southeast of Wetland 1. USGS Hillshade maps and LIDAR 2-foot elevation contours do not indicate above ground direct surface hydrological connection to (a)(1)-(3) water. FEMA maps indicate that the wetland is located in Zone X -Minimal Flood Hazard and therefore would not be subject to flooding from an (a)(1)-(3) in a typical year. The wetland does not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR and therefore is not jurisdictional under Navigable Wasters Protection Rule and the Clean Water Act.
