Wetland 2	0.91	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	Wetland 2 is a shrub-carr (Type 6) wetland located on the north side of Trunk Highway (TH) 71 at the intersection of Town Hall Road. The wetland is 0.91 acre within the construction limits of the project and is part of a larger NWI wetland area that extends west beyond the construction limits. Aerial photography and topographic mapping indicate this larger wetland area drains south along the TH 71 roadside ditch and may contribute surface water flow to several downstream waters, including an unnamed tributary to Lake Bemidji. However, based on additional data sources including national wetland and hydrography data, this segment of the TH 71 roadside ditch is man-made and is not a relocated tributary, is not constructed in a tributary, and is not constructed in adjacent wetlands. Based on this information, the TH 71 roadside ditch is not considered a tributary and, therefore, does not provide a sufficient hydrologic surface connection to meet the adjacency criteria in the Navigable Waters Project Rule (NWPR).
				Based on this review, Wetland 2 is not jurisdictional under the NWPR because it meets the requirements of the exclusion for non-adjacent wetlands under paragraph (b)(1). The assessed wetland does not abut jurisdictional waters, is not inundated by flooding from a traditional navigable water, or tributary, or from a jurisdictional lake, pond, or impoundment, and is not physically separated from a jurisdictional water by only a natural feature or artificial structure that allows for a direct hydrologic surface connection. This was confirmed by reviewing the data sources in Section III.A.
Wet Ditch 2-4 and 6-10	1.20	acre(s)	(b)(5) Ditch that is not an (a)(1) or (a)(2) water, and those portions of	Wet Ditch 2-4 and 6-10 were constructed in uplands to convey runoff from the adjacent roadway and are now linear wetlands that meet the definition of "ditch" under paragraph (c)(2).

These four sub-categories are not new exclusions, but are simply administrative distinctions and remain (b)(1) exclusions as defined by the NWPR.

In addition, the ditches are not (a)(1) waters, are not relocated tributaries, are not constructed in a tributary, and are not constructed in an adjacent wetland. This was confirmed by reviewing aerial photography, national hydrography data, and the wetland delineation report. Based on this review, the assessed ditches are not jurisdictional under the NWPR because they meet the requirements of the exclusion for ditches under paragraph (b)(5).
