There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

 - Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: This AJD is limited to the boundaries of Wetland 2. Based on review of aerial imagery and the wetland delineation information submitted by the requestor, we have determined that the wetland is isolated with boundaries that transition to uplands.

Wetland 2 is located centrally within the site boundary. Review of aerial imagery does not show a surface water connection to a water of the U.S. (WoUS). This is also supported by the National Hydrography Dataset (NHD). The wetland is not mapped on the National Wetland Inventory (NWI) and 2-foot LiDAR contours support that the wetland is in a generally flat, depressional area. Additional sample data points were collected by the wetland delineatior around the perimeter of the delineated wetland and were deemed non-wetland.

Wetland 2 does not support links to interstate or foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. The wetland does not have an ecological connection to a WoUS. Furthermore, the area is hydrologically isolated with no surface water connections to a WoUS. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetland 2 is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
