B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE

REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: According to the off-site assessment, the project area is currently used for agricultural production. No watercourses, basins, or wetlands are identified on the National Wetlands Inventory or the MN DNR Public Waters Inventory. The USGS NHD map shows that an unnamed intermittent tributary is located approximately 700' north of the project area but it does not extend into the project area. In addition, the Waseca County Soil Survey Map shows predominately non-hydric soils throughout the project area.
