Project Description and Purpose:

The applicant proposes to replace an existing boathouse on the Mississippi River near RM 725.5. The applicant currently has a boathouse measuring 12 feet wide by 24 feet long at slip #501 on Latsch Island. The current location is hard to access due to accumulating sediment, therefore the applicant is proposing to remove the structure at this location and rebuild at a new site on Latsch Island. The new structure would be 20 feet wide, 30 feet long, and 16 feet high. A plank measuring 4 feet wide and 40 feet long would provide access from the shoreline.

Federally Listed Threatened and Endangered Species:

According to the USFWS Midwest Region website, which was checked on March 29, 2016, the Northern long-eared bat (threatened), Eastern massasauga (proposed as threatened), Higgins eye pearl mussel (endangered), Sheepsnose (endangered), and Karner blue butterfly (endangered) are found in Winona County, Minnesota.

Historic Properties:

The latest version of the National Register of Historic Places has been consulted and no listed properties (known to be eligible for inclusion, or included in the Register) are located in the project area.
