PolyMet Mining submits permit application
July 16, 2004

MPCA issues CWA Section 401 Certification Dec 20, 2018 Corps completes ROD and issues Standard Permit March 21, 2019

Band files suit Sept 10, 2019


Corps suspends Section 404 CWA permit March 17, 2021

Court grants EPA motion March 8, 2021 EPA files motion for voluntary remand and requests Corps to suspend permit March 4, 2021 Court rules EPA had a nondiscretionary duty Feb 16, 2021

EPA issues "May Affect" Determination June 4, 2021 Band submits objection to Section 404 CWA permit and requests a public hearing Aug 3, 2021

Public Hearing May 3-5 2022

- Standard CWA Section 404 Permit for NorthMet Mine
 - Authorized 901 acres of wetlands fill and 27 acres of indirect loss of wetlands
- Permit is suspended and no authorized work has occurred on site
