PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE: The applicant proposes to discharge fill material into 0.66 acres of wetlands in conjunction with the reconstruction of Woodland Drive. The project will include the reconstruction of Woodland Drive with 12 foot travel lanes and 5 foot paved shoulders from Mary Lake Road to County Highway M, the construction of a 10 foot wide multi-use path parallel to the road and the construction of a parking lot on the WDNR property near the intersection with Mary Lake Road.

The project purpose consists of enhancing the use of Woodland Drive as a minor arterial connection by repairing deteriorating road surface, substandard shoulders and the need to provide on-road bike lanes and a separate secure off-road bike/pedestrian path.

NAME, AREA AND TYPES OF WATERS (INCLUDING WETLANDS) SUBJECT TO LOSS: The project will result in the discharge of fill material into 0.30 acre of fresh wet meadow, 0.22 acre of shrub/carr, and 0.14 acre of floodplain forest.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED: The applicant considered the “No Build” alternative but this was dismissed because it would not address the deteriorating and substandard road surface conditions and would not provide for public safety and recreational trail improvements.

The applicant considered the “Build West Path” alternative which is the preferred alternative. This alternative addresses the deteriorating and substandard road surface conditions and provides for public safety and recreational trail improvements by collaborating with the WDNR to provide a recreational trail and parking lot for access to public lands.

The applicant considered the “Build East Path” alternative which is very similar to the “Build West Path” and may have resulted in slightly less wetland impacts but would have required land acquisition or private easements and the recreational path would have commercial and / or road intersections with the recreational trail.

Federally Listed Threatened and Endangered Species:

None were identified by the applicant or are known to exist in the project area. However Dane County is within the known historic range for the following Federally-listed species: Northern long eared bat (threatened), Higgins eye pearly mussel (endangered), Sheepnose (endangered), Eastern prairie fringed orchid (threatened), Mead’s milkweed (threatened), and Prairie bush-clover (threatened).

COMPENSATORY MITIGATION: The applicant plans to buy 0.79 floodplain forest mitigation credits from Tallgrass Land Conservation Bass Creek Wetland Mitigation, LLC to mitigate for the discharge of fill material into a total of 0.66 acre of wetland for the reconstruction of Woodland Drive.
