SECTION II: SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

B. CWA SECTION 404 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

 - Explain: The review area contains one 0.40-acre intrastate wetland (Wetland B) and is not a water of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing the Surface Water Data Viewer (SWDV), NRCS Soil Survey data, Milwaukee County topographic map, the 2016 Wetland & Waterway consulting wetland delineation report, and aerial photographs from 1928, 1937, 1951, 1963, 1970, 1980, 1990, 2000, 2005, 2010, 2013, 2015, and 2018. Wetland B is a 0.40-acre shallow marsh and fresh wet meadow and is described as a depressional basin in the wetland delineation report. No inlets or outlets to Wetland B are visible in any of the aerial photos reviewed from 1928 to 2018. The nearest waterbody is Wilson Park Creek located approximately 250 feet north.

Wetland B is isolated with no surface or shallow subsurface connection to jurisdictional waters. It is not bordering, neighboring or contiguous with another water of the U.S. and is not separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. The site is located in an urban area and the surrounding land use is dominated by residential and commercial development. The disturbance of surrounding land uses precludes an ecological connection to a WOUS. The wetland does not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetland B is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.


