Explain: This determination is only for the wetland labeled as Wetland B on the enclosed figures labeled MVP-2017-02949-LMG Page 1 of 4 through 4 of 4. Wetland B does not have a surface or shallow subsurface hydrologic connection to any navigable waters or their tributaries, as confirmed in the Gateway EVOC Track Site Wetland Delineation Report dated September 15, 2016. The wetland is surrounded by uplands and has no swales, pipes or other means to connect it to waters of the U.S. (WOUS). We have determined that the wetland is an isolated depression and not a water of the U.S.

Wetland B does not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce because it is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate or foreign commerce. The wetland does not have an ecological connection to other waters within the review area. The waterbody was determined to not be jurisdictional under the CWA.
