 - Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: There are three ornamental ponds in the review area (Pond 1 is 0.22-acre, Pond 2 is 0.11-acre, and Pond 3 is 0.67-acre in size). These bodies of water were constructed in uplands (Pond 1 constructed between 1980-1990, Pond 2 constructed between 1990-1995, and Pond 3 constructed between 1963-1970) and are not waters of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing Waukesha County GIS aerial photos 1941 to 1995. There did not appear to be areas of consistent and prolonged saturation or inundation present on aerial photos.

The non-jurisdictional determination for these three ornamental ponds is in accordance with the preamble to the 1986 Corps Regulations (33 CFR Parts 320-330), which states that the Corps does not generally consider the following to be waters of the U.S.; artifical reflecting or swimming pools or other small ornamental bodies of water created by excavating and/or diking dry land to retain water for primarily aesthetic reasons.
