These wetlands are labeled Wetland 1 Wetland 10 on the attached figure. The wetland delineation work performed by Davel Engineering & Environmental, Inc. characterizes these wetlands as isolated depressions. These wetlands are not within the 100-year floodplain and are not bordering, contiguous or neighboring another WOUS nor are these aquatic resource separated from another WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. The wetlands located within the review areas do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Furthermore, these wetlands are hydologically isolated with no surface or shallow subsurface connectons to a water of the United States and do not have an ecological interconnection due to existing disturbance and/or distance from the nearest tributary. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetlands 1 10 are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.




Wetland Delineation Overview Map




