A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

 - Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area contains two intrastate wetlands (Wetlands 1 and 4) that are not waters of the U.S. This was confirmed by reviewing the Surface Water Data Viewer (SWDV), Washington County topographic map, the 2018 ra Smith wetland delineation report, and Google Earth aerial photographs from 1992 to 2018. Wetland 1 is mapped as a scrub shrub wetland in the SWDV and is described as depression in the delineation report. Wetland 4 is not mapped in the SWDV and is located directly south of W. Washington Street. No inlets or outlets to Wetlands 1 and 4 are visible in any of the aerial or ground level photos reviewed. The wetlands are located approximately 3,150 feet away from the nearest juisdictional waterbody, a tributary to Silver Creek, which does not provide an ecological connection.

Wetlands 1 and 4 are isolated with no surface or shallow surface connection to jurisdictional waters. They are not bordering, neighboring or contiguous with another water of the U.S. and are not separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers, or berms. These wetlands do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetlands 1 and 4 are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
