A public telephone is located adjacent to the parking lot at the information center.

FIRST AID

The park staff is trained to provide First Aid and CPR.

Camping

1. Reservations may be made by calling 1-877-444-6777 or by visiting website www.reserveusa.com. TDD: 1-877-833-6777
2. Vacant reservable campsites may be available for up to two days without a reservation.
3. Fees are collected by a ranger on patrol.
4. Campsites must be occupied by, or under the supervision of, an adult.
5. Vehicles, camping tents, trailers, and other equipment must be completely accommodated on the camping pad and driveway surface. Only one wheeled camping unit will be permitted per campsite.
6. The unauthorized placement of camping equipment or other items on a campsite and/or personal appearance at a campsite for the purpose of reserving a campsite for future occupancy is prohibited.
7. Camping in the park is limited to 14 days in any 30-day period.
8. Check-out time: 12 Noon
9. Quiet Hours: 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Please respect the privileges and privacy of others at all times.
10. Campsites are available all year round.
11. Only two motorized vehicles per site.

NOTICE: All persons entering upon Government property do so at their own risk. The United States assumes no responsibility for their loss or injury from the acts or conduct of other persons on the premises.

General Rules

To ensure the enjoyment and safety of park users, we ask that you observe the following rules:

1. Fires are allowed in fireplaces or grills only.
2. Please do not cut, mark, or peel any trees. Firewood is available in the campground.
3. Drive with care and obey all posted traffic regulations. Motorized and trailered vehicles must be kept on improved surfaces only.
4. Off-road (ATV) vehicles are prohibited.
5. Pets are allowed but must be kept on a maximum 6-foot leash. Pets disturbing other campers must be removed from the park. Owners are responsible for cleanup of all excrement.
7. The use or display of firearms, air rifles, bows and arrows, slingshots and fireworks is strictly prohibited.
8. Please report any acts of vandalism, disturbances, or loss of personal property to the park ranger, manager or campground host.
9. Glass containers, aluminum cans and tabs, and pets are not allowed on the swimming beach.
9. Refuse will be dumped and gray water will be drained in the designated areas only.



Gull Lake Recreation Area




Gull Lake Dam controls the runoff from 287 square miles of drainage area and the ten lakes of the Gull Lake chain. The dam raised the lake level approximately five feet. The area around Gull Lake Dam was inhabited several times since 800 B.C. and is the site of several Native American burial mounds. Gull Lake occupies a basin formed by a receding glacier. In the early 1900s it provided water for navigation in the Mississippi River below the Twin Cities and for floating logs to sawmills. Now the dam is utilized for flood control and to enhance recreation.
