## Camping

- Reservations may be made by calling 1-877-444-6777 or by visiting website [www.reserveusa.com](http://www.reserveusa.com).
- Open reservable sites are available for two nights without reservations.
- Fees are collected by a ranger on patrol.
- Campers must vacate site by noon on the last day of their visit.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Please respect the privileges and privacy of others at all times.
- Camping tents, trailers, and other equipment must be completely accommodated on the camping pad and driveway surface. Only one wheeled camping unit will be permitted per campsite.
- The unauthorized placement of camping equipment or other items on a campsite and/or personal appearance at a campsite for the purpose of reserving a campsite for future occupancy is prohibited.

**NOTICE:** All persons entering upon Government property do so at their own risk. The United States assumes no responsibility for their loss or injury from the acts or conduct of other persons on the premises.

## General Rules

To ensure the enjoyment and safety of park users, we ask that you observe the following rules:

- Fires are allowed in fireplaces or grills only.
- Please do not cut, mark, or peel any trees. Firewood is available in the campground.
- Drive with care and obey all posted traffic regulations. Motorized and trailered vehicles must be kept on gravel or paved surfaces.
- Off-road (ATV) vehicles are prohibited.
- Please observe the rules concerning safe boat operations. Boats may be beached at designated areas only. The mooring canal is for the exclusive use of registered campers.
- Pets are allowed but must be kept on a maximum 6-foot leash. Pets disturbing other campers must be removed from the park. Owners are responsible for cleanup of all excrement.
- The use or display of firearms, air rifles, bows and arrows, slingshots and fireworks is strictly prohibited.
- Please report any acts of vandalism, disturbances, or loss of personal property to the park ranger, manager or campground host.
- Refuse will be dumped and gray water will be drained in the designated areas only.
- Please use our recycle area whenever possible.
- There is no designated swimming area.



# Leech Lake Recreation Area



Leech Lake fills a basin formed by receding glaciers. The 126,000-acre reservoir, formed upon construction of the dam in 1884, controls the runoff from a 1,163-square mile drainage area, contains 316 miles of shoreline and encompasses about 14 natural lakes. Lake levels were raised approximately two feet after impoundment. The dam is located on the Leech Lake River, 214 river miles from the source of the Mississippi River at Lake Itasca, 27 river miles from the confluence with the Mississippi, and 1,254 river miles from the mouth at the Gulf of Mexico.
