A review of available resources confirmed the wetland investigated is located within an enclosed depression that has no surface water connections to intermittent or perennial tributaries. The investigated wetland is physically removed from the nearest A(1)-A(3) water, and there is no evidence that it is directly abutting an A(1) – A(3) water. The investigated wetland was determined to be hydrologically isolated and is therefore not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.


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






### WETLAND DELINEATION MAP
