B. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD: The No Wetland Determination Memorandum submitted for this project adequately supports and doccuments that there are no aquatic resources within the review area identified on the attached figures labeled MVP-2021-02374-SSC, Pages 1-2 of 2. A sample point was taken in a low spot along the northern site boarder and was determined to be non-wetland due to a lack of wetland hydrology indicators and hydric soils. There are no tributaries on-site. Additionally, the National Wetland Inventory (NWI) does not map any wetlands within the review area, the soil is characterised as non-hydric (Zimmerman), and the National Hydrography Dataset (NHD) does not have any mapped surface waters within the site. Based on this info, the project site does not contain any aquatic resources and has been determined to be upland.
