C. Additional comments to support AJD: Aerial photos taken May 2017, April 2015, August 2012, June 2010, October 2009, June 2009, May 2008, May 2006, August 2004, May 2003, and April 1991 were reviewed as part of this AJD. The rill present in the location of A-S1 was observed in several years; however, no surface was present in any of the aerial photos. Water was observed in A-S1 at the time of the delineation (July 18, 2019). The delineation was conducted during wetter than normal conditions for the three prior months, which resulted in rainfall of more than 6 inches above normal for the three prior months; therefore, conditions at the time of the delineation are not considered typical.
