Wetland 1	2.12	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non- adjacent wetland.	The joint application states that that Wetland 1 is a large depression that receives surface water from surrounding uplands. The Contour Map submitted in the delineation report indicates that Wetland 1 is a depressional basin, completely surrounded by uplands. This was confirmed using Google Earth imagery. Wetland 1 does not share a surface water connection with an a(1)- a(3) water. Therefore, Wetland 1 is not considered a water of the U.S. under the Navigable Waters Protection Rule.
Wetlands 2 and 3	0.48	acre(s)	(b)(10) Stormwater control feature constructed or excavated in upland or in a non-jurisdictional water to convey, treat, infiltrate, or store stormwater runoff.	The application states that Wetlands 2 and 3 were excavated in uplands for the purpose of stormwater treatment. Google Earth aerial imagery confirmed the applicant's findings. Google Earth imagery indicated that Wetlands 2 and 3 were constructed in uplands between 2016 and 2017. Based on this information, Wetlands 2 and 3 are not waters of the U.S. under the Navigable Waters Protection Rule.
