This AJD is limited to the boundaries Wetland 2. These boundaries are shown on the attached figures labeled, "2022-01533-ACM AJD Attachments, Pages 1-2 of 2". Based on the wetland delineation report submitted by the requestor, aerial imagery, including LiDAR contours, we have determined that Wetland 2 is isolated. Wetland 2 is located in an isolated depression, surrounded by uplands. The adjacent uplands all drain into Wetland 2. This is supported by the National Wetland Inventory (NWI) and National Hydrography Dataset (NHD). Wetland 2 does not have a surface water connection or known shallow subsurface connections to downstream waters. The nearest tributary is the Middle Fork Crow River, approximately 1000 feet south of Wetland 2. Wetland 2 is not located in a floodplain. Wetland 2 is surrounded by roads, a golf course, and residential development. There are no culverts, tile lines, or inlets/outlets connected to Wetland 2.

Wetland 2 does not support links to interstate or foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Wetland 2 does not have an ecological connection to a water of the United States. Therefore, the Corps has determined that Wetland 2 is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
