SECTION II: SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

B. CWA SECTION 404 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: Based on a review of historic aerial photography, topographic maps, and the wetland delineation report submitted by the requestor, we have determined that Wetland 1 is an isolated wetland depression. The north, west, and east boundaries of Wetland 1 transitions into upland while the south boundaries extends outside of the review area. After evaluation of the soils, topography, and aerial imagery, we have determined that extent of Wetland 1's southern boundary, outside of the review area transitions into uplands. As depicted in aerial imagery, the wetland signatures observed within the delineated wetland feature do not extend outside of the wetland and is surrounded entirely by uplands. In addition, the review area has minor changes in elevation, as show in the USGS topo maps.

Wetland 1 does not abut and is not separated from any waters of the U.S. by natural or man-made features. The nearest mapped tributary is a tributary to the Mullet River located approximately 1,201 feet north of Wetland 1. Historical aerial photography did not depict any wet signatures in the immediate areas and no surface water or ecological connections are present that link this wetland to the tributary or other aquatic resources. Based on this information, Wetland 1 is ecologically separated from all other aquatic resources.

Wetland 1 does not support a link to interstate foreign commerce; is not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; does not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and is not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined this aquatic feature is not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
