<u>SECTION II: SUMMARY OF FINDINGS</u> A. RHA SECTION 10 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no "navigable waters of the U.S." within Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 329) in the review area.

B. CWA SECTION 404 DETERMINATION OF JURISDICTION.

There are no"waters of the U.S." within Clean Water Act (CWA) jurisdiction (as defined by 33 CFR part 328) in the review area.

 - Potentially jurisdictional waters and/or wetlands were assessed within the review area and determined to be not jurisdictional. Explain: The review area contains 2 intrastate wetlands (Wetland 3 and Wetland 4) as described in the RA Smith National Wetland Delineation Report dated November 27, 2019. Both wetlands are entirely contained within the review area. There are no surface or shallow subsurface connections to the nearest waterway, a tributary to the Des Plaines River, approximately 400 feet to the north. Hydrology within Wetland 3 and Wetland 4 is the result of surface water runoff from the surrounding upland farm fields. Wetland 3 slopes north from an elevation of 692' down to 685', whereas the larger wetland complex adjacento the tributary to Des Plaines River begins at the 681' contour. Wetland 4 is contained entirely within the 684' and 685' contours. These wetlands do not border nor are contiguous with another water of the U.S. They are not separated from other WOUS by man-made dikes, barriers or berms. These wetlands are surrounded by a mixture of residential and agricultural development as well as a golf course across the road to the east. The disturbance of the surrounding land uses precludes an ecological connection to a WOUS.

These aquatic resources do not support a link to interstate or foreign commerce; are not known to be used by interstate or foreign travelers for recreation or other purposes; do not produce fish or shellfish that could be taken and sold in interstate or foreign commerce; and are not known to be used for industrial purposes by industries in interstate commerce. Therefore, the Corps has determined that these wetlands are not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.


