Wetland 2	0.02	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	Based on a review of the wetland delineation map, Wetland 2 is located in a depressional area and is surrounded by uplands involving an open fallow field on all sides. The delineation map shows wetland boundaries are contained within the review area and a review of historical aerial photos provided in the report and via Google Earth (photos taken 05/2018, 04/2017, 04/2015, 10/2011, 05/2011, 06/2010, 06/2008, 06/2006, 05/2005, 04/1992) primarily taken during the wetter months of the year, illustrate mostly dry conditions within the area. The Wisconsin Surface Water Data Viewer indicates the nearest (a)(1)-(a)(3) water is an unnamed tributary approximately 0.04 mile west and a review of a floodplain map indicates there is no mapped floodplain for this tributary. A review of a topographic map provided via Calumet County GIS shows a decrease in elevation from 778 to 770 towards the tributary. The presence of uplands around the wetland, the change in elevation, and aerial and ground level photography, all indicate this wetland does not abut the tributary to the west, is not separated from this water by natural or man-made barriers and does not receive flooding in a typical year from this water of the U.S. Based on this information, Wetland 2 is a (b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland, and is therefore not regulated by the Corps under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
