### **II. FINDINGS**

The review area is comprised entirely of dry land (i.e., there are no waters or water features, including wetlands, of any kind in the entire review area). Rationale: The review area includes a 50.8 acre parce
that is currently in agricultural production. The Blue Earth County Soil Survey identifies the site as
hydric soil (Muskego soils, 0 to 1 percent slopes). The site is located in a basin that has been subject
to drainage activities since at least 1939 as evidence in aerial photos. A drainage ditch was initially cu
through the middle of the parcel. By 1979 the ditch was moved to the west edge of the parcel, outside
of the review area. A delineation was completed on the site on July 17, 2020. The delineation
determined that wetland signatures were only present 24% of all years as observed in aerial photo
review. NWI and NHD maps confirm no waters or water features in the review area. USGS
Topographic Map depicts wetland and County Ditch Number 5 within the review area; however, aerial
photo review as described above confirmed that is not the current condition. Aerial slide review, NWI
map, and NHD described above confirm that the review area has been effectively drained and no
waters or water features are located in the review area.
